	<p>Distinguished Flying Cross reverse dated 1945 1939/45 Star; Africa Star; Italy Star; War medal; Africa Service medal officially impressed 28351 R.T. Hutchinson South African Death Plaque for WW II inscribed "Died on Service" The Irwin Caterpillar engraved Lt R.T. Hutchinson with the membership card for the Caterpillar club. Observers and Air Gunners Flying log book starts 6/12/41 and ends July 13<sup>th</sup> 1944. There are some original black and white photos and a few newspaper cuttings . Nine pages of copies of his service record show that these medals are all that he was issued. He attested 10-4-40. 2<sup>nd</sup> Lt air gunner 23 Squadron SAAF. Promoted from TLT to TCapt whilst filling post of Group Leader 12 Sqdn. Injured in flying battle 8-12-43. Captured 13-7-44 wounded Reclassified P.O.W. Released P.O.W. arrived U.K.14-5-45 Died Kisumu 4-6-46 Killed accidentally. The citation for the DFC reads as follows. "Particulars of meritorious service for which high recommendation is made. A Gunner who has on his second operational tour ,having completed a first tour of 32 Sorties in the desert campaign in which he served with distinction. As a result of enemy action his aircraft forced landed on two occasions. At Tobruk and during the retreat from Gazala. He has been in combat on 4 or 5 occasions and though no victories were claimed he has always shown coolness and utter disregard for danger which has been a most encouraging example to the members of his squadron. After completeing a coastal Recce of 63 sorties,Capt. Hutchinson returned om his second operational tour and showed unflinching courage on the 8<sup>th</sup> December 1943 when this squadron attacked an enemy camp at Wigland Cross roads and whilst bombing the target the aircraft was hit by flak and caught fire in the bomb bay. Although blinded by smoke he attempted to put the fire out at the same time warning the Pilot to make for our lines. After an unsuccessul attempt to quell the fire the pilot gave orders to bailout which he did and was flying again ten days later. Capt Hutchinson who was the squadron gunnery officer continued to display outstanding qualities of leadership particularly when morale was running low. Capt Hutinson was shot down and wounded on 13 July 1944 at Moriwarchi in the aircraft of Col Barnby D.F.C. Squadron commanderat the time and is now a P.O.W. "</p>
