In August 1942 it joined No 8 Group RAF it became one of the original pathfinder squadrons, converting to Lancasters in January 1943. 	<i>made a quick appreciation and realising that the platoon ahead of his had not received the orders given, and the imperative need for these orders to be conveyed to the platoon concerned, correctly and in the minimum of time, decided to forward himself and ensure that there would be no mistake. This he achieved and the advance continued immediately. During the advance over most difficult country, steep and thickly wooded, he frequently went right forward himself under heavy mortar and shell-fire to ensure reaching his objective. Finally, on reaching his objective in the face on intense shell, mortar and small arms fire from the front and both flanks, he coolly walked round the position indicating section posts for consolidation. His courage and outstanding leadership were an inspiration to his men."</i>
