James Spencer Oddy was born in Natal around 1897 and attested for the 3rd South African Infantry at Potchefstroom on 3 September 1915. At the time of attestation, he was employed by the Modder B Gold Mine in Brakpan as an electrician. Posted to the Western Front with “B” Company from 19 July 1916, he later, as a Signaler, suffered a compound fracture to the left forearm on the 8 th October 1918, probably as part of the South African attack beyond Beauvoir (page 234 – John Buchans book, ‘The South African Forces in France’). He was evacuated to Military Hospital in Richmond. Complete with 35 pages of research.	VF	200
G	005	WW1 Victory Medal named to 9054 Private H(Henry). Smallbone – 3 rd South African Infantry. Henry Smallbone was born in Berkshire, England, around 1877, and attested for the 3rd South African Infantry at Potchefstroom on 13 January 1916. In October he attested with the 5 th South African Infantry (Kaffarian Rifles), being released in June 1915. He re-attested, later that month for service in German South-West Africa with the 10 th Infantry (Witwatersrand Rifles). Posted to the Western Front 6 August 1916 with the 3 rd South African Infantry, he was soon evacuated to England suffering from myalgia on 1 September 1916, being discharged medically unfit at	VF	200

		Wynberg on 10 January 1917, aged 39 years complete with (16 pages of research).		
G		WW1 Victory Medal named to 7385 Private E(Ernest). C(Cecil). Baker – 4 th South African Infantry. Ernest Cecil Baker was born in Kimberley and attested for the 4th South African Infantry at Potchefstroom on 24 November 1915. He indicated that he had spent 6 years with the Jeppe Central Cadets. Posted to France 29 June 1916, his papers record that he suffered a gunshot wound to the head and right hand on 9 th December 1917. John Buchans book, 'The South African Forces in France' records (page 153) – <i>“All through December the Brigade was heavily shelled. During the first week the casualties averaged throughout the Brigade about thirty a day, which were severe for trench warfare.”</i> Evacuated to the Royal Victoria Hospital, he was later discharged at Maitland on 28 May 1919. Complete with (20 pages of research).	VF	200
G	006	WW1 Victory Medal named to 13568 Private N(Nicholaas). J(Johannes). Thomson – 4 th South African Infantry. Nicholas Johannes Thomson was born in Richmond, Cape Province, around 1896, and attested for the 4th South African Infantry on 24 March 1917. Embarked at Cape Town per Euripidies on 20 April 1917, his papers state that he suffered a severe shrapnel wound to the arm on 22 nd March 1918. John Buchans book, 'The South African Forces in France' records (pages 170 – 174, with a map on page 174) – <i>“The retirement of the 4th Regiment was only made possible by an accurate supporting fire from the 2nd.”</i> Evacuated from the Western Front, he was discharged at Maitland in November 1919.
